



Rules of Using QAC24.com Internet Service

§ 1

General Provisions

The following rules specify the conditions of operation and use of the internet service, hereafter referred to as the “Service”, functioning at the website address www.qac24.com.

The Rules specify the rights and obligations of registered Users, as well as the rights, obligations and the scope of responsibility of the Administrator in charge of managing and running the Service. At the time of registration, each new User is obliged to familiarize themselves with the content of the Rules and can take further actions after a prior consent to, and acceptance of, all of its provisions. These rules are available at the internet address www.qac24.com.

The Owner and Administrator of the Service is Pro-Project, seated at Okszow (22-105), Kwiatowa 43A. The company’s registration address is: Wolnosci 35/15, 22-100 Chełm.

The object of the Service is to provide a user-transparent archive of test results for any number of devices for image diagnostics, as well as an automatic analysis of phantom images along with an option to verify which test has not been passed and why.

At the moment each User has performed what it takes to start using the Service, they are obliged to follow the provisions of these Rules. Before creating a Service account, they should familiarize themselves with the following Rules.





§ 2

Definitions

The meaning of terms and expressions used in these Rules is as follows:

Rules – a set of provisions which the User must accept as a whole if they are going to use the Service, constituting all the provisions between the User and the Service Administrator for any directives of using the Service.

Service – the internet service at www.qac24.com as an internet platform administered by Pro-Project, seated at Okszow, which among others is made up of a set of services provided for the Users electronically.

Administrator – the person being the owner of the Service, responsible for its management and running, which is Pro-Project, seated at Chełm (22-100), Wolnosci 35/15, 22-100.

User – a natural person, a legal person or an organizing unit without legal entity, using the Service and its services.

User account – an account in the Service opened by the User in harmony with these Rules.

QAC – „*Quality Control Centre*”, also known as Service.

§ 3

Basic Information and Technical Conditions for Using the Service

1. The Administrator and owner of the Service is Pro-Project, seated at Okszow (22-105), Kwiatowa 43A..
2. In order to use the services of the Service, it is necessary to possess devices facilitating the use of Internet resources, an email account, and a web browser making it possible to display WWW websites (the use of the most recent web browsers is recommended, with “cookie” files option enabled). In order to use the services provided by the Service correctly, it is necessary to possess the following software: Windows Media Player 9 or higher, Adobe Flash Player 9 or higher, and Adobe Reader XI.
3. Registration consists in filling in a registration form available at the home page of the Service.





4. To start the Service, you should do the following:
 - register in the Service giving your nick, password, and email address;
 - pay for access to the Service by internet transfer or promotion code.
5. Using the Service is paid.
6. All payments for the services provided by the Service are made by electronic payments or promotion codes.
7. In order to use the services of the Service, the User must each time log on into the Service through the logging form available at the home page.
8. Users' accounts are the exclusive property of the Service Administrator. The User cannot, free of a charge or for a fee, transfer the account to other Users or third parties.
9. The technical conditions of using the Service are essentially significant for the proper functioning of the Service, its correct display in the web browser used by the User, as well as for the safety of the User's data stored in the Account of the Service. Each User should observe the following conditions and directives, and any other actions taken by the User (intentionally or unintentionally) shall be his sole responsibility.

§ 4

Services

1. Through the Service the Users can:
 - create a transparent archive of test results for any number of radiological devices;
 - automatically analyse test images of quality control sets;
 - verify which test has not been passed and why;
 - define the range of tests carried out, individually for each radiological device;
 - print reports.





2. The range of access, or the range and way of providing the individual services of the Service, both the existing ones and those to be introduced in the future, can be amended at any time (expanded or limited) by the Administrator, which also concerns the possibility of adding or removing the individual services by the User. The above may depend on the User having to meet some extra conditions.
3. The Administrator commits himself to informing on the Service's pages about each and every change in the range of services and the reasons thereof.

§ 5

Rules for Using the Service

1. It is considered unlawful to use the Service, its every functionality, or the individual extra services for other purposes – contrary to, or inappropriate under, the nature and subject of the Service.
2. Using the Service for other purposes than those resulting from the nature and subject of the Service requires the consent of the Service Administrator in writing. Without the consent of the Service Administrator, it is especially forbidden to copy the content as a whole or in parts, make any changes, duplicate or use it in any other way for commercial purposes. The User accepts that the content put up in the Service is subject to protection based on copyright law, related laws, and other legal regulations.

§ 6

Responsibility

1. The Administrator shall spare no effort to make the Service and all its services operate in a continuous way, without any interruptions whatsoever. However, the Administrator shall not be held responsible for interruptions resulting from other parties, caused by force majeure or by unlawful interference on the part of the Users or third parties.





2. Pro-Project shall not be held responsible for any damages or losses incurred by the User as a result of using the Service or lack of access to it.
3. The Administer reserves the right to temporarily, entirely or partly disable the Service, or the individual elements making up the Service, in order to improve it, add new services or carry out maintenance works, without having to notify the Users in advance through the Service.
4. Without the Administrator's consent, it is forbidden to copy, distribute or use in any other way, as a whole or in parts, information, data, multimedia materials, or other content from the Service, except for cases of lawful use in line with copyright law and related laws of Feb.4, 1994.

§ 7

Complaints procedure

1. Interruptions in the Service operation can be complained about by the User by reporting dysfunctions to the Administrator through email, sending a message to contact@pro-project.pl
2. The complaint shall be examined within seven days from the date of reporting it to the Service Administrator along with a justification of the stand taken. Whenever justified, the deadline of seven days shall be extended.
3. The Administrator reserves the right to leave a complaint unanswered, if it concerns a dysfunction resulting from ignoring the Rules, the User's not complying with the directions systematically given to the Users through the Service, or directly by the Administrator.
4. The Administrator reserves the right to interfere in the technical structure of the User's Account in order to diagnose irregularities in the services provided by the Service. Also, he shall make changes in, and in every other way influence, the technical aspects of the Account in order to modify it or restore the proper operation of the Account as such or of the Service.
5. The complaints procedure shall not involve having to incur extra fees.





§ 8

Amending the Rules

Any provisions of the Rules are subject to change by the Administrator. The changes shall be made known systematically in the form of a unified text of Rules through the Service along with information about their being made.

§ 9

Final Provisions

1. The Service shall not gather nor make available any personal data of the Users. While registering in the Service, the User is obliged only to give the nick, password, and the email address.
2. The Rules constitute a whole of internal provisions between the Administrator and the Users.
3. While accepting the Rules, the User declares that they have familiarised themselves with all of its provisions and do not raise any objections to their content or form, and agree to follow the entire content of the Rules.
